

PHOTOGRAPHIC IMAGES.

You have already received a copy of our Standard Collection Notice in the Parent Information Booklet. This letter is to let you know that during the course of the year, staff may take photographic images of your child using either digital photographs or video footage. Children may be taking part in special school events such as sports carnivals, receiving awards at assembly, be participating in classroom activities or be part of a group out in the playground. These images and associated children's names may then be placed in a variety of situations including the classroom intranet site, the school website, school newsletters, power point presentations of special school events. A printed copy of the digital image may be made and pinned up in the school.

Occasionally, other publishers request photos and information relating to school activities. No photographs of individual children will be passed on to any outside person or agency without the permission of the parents.

Throughout the course of a child's education at St Simon Peter School, photographs and videos will be stored as part of the school history. At the end of year seven when children are graduating from primary school, it is possible to collate suitable pictures into a power point presentation depicting their school life from kindergarten to the end of year seven. This power point presentation is burnt onto a CD and given to each graduating child as a memento of their primary school years at St Simon Peter School.

Parents are usually happy to see such images of their children displayed. However, if a parent does not wish to have photographs of their children viewed by others in the manner described above please send a written note addressed to the Principal informing us of your wishes.
